




Percentage of children <5 years old stunted


Percentage of children <5 years old underweight





Prevalence of anaemia among selected populations



Percentage of households with adequately iodized salt




Vitamin A supplementation

Percentage of children 6–59 months old receiving two doses of vitamin A during calendar year (full coverage)






Improved drinking water coverage Percentage of population, by type of drinking water source, 1990–2010
